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The West Point-Town of Highlands Farmers Market will be implementing the following directives for the 2021 market season, subject to revision as conditions permit. These policies are in conformance with the New York State of Opportunity, Agriculture and Markets Interim Guidance for the Operation of Farmers' Markets.

Policy revisions notated in **red**.

- Each vendor site will be spaced 6 feet apart from the adjacent vendor.
- Vendors should encourage customers to comply with social distancing.
- State mandate for vendors to wear masks & gloves.
- Vendors recommended to have one person handle cash and customer interaction where feasible.
- ~~Customers should not touch products.~~ **May touch items but at a minimum.** - Rev_6.7.21
- Vendors will bring packaged product/product to customers.
- ~~No open product samplings.~~ **Sampling and the consumption of food and/or beverages may be permitted in a designated food area where individuals are seated.** - Rev_6.7.21
- Prepackaging of products, e.g., bread, baked goods, meats, pickled items, etc. ~~required~~ **are encouraged.** - Rev_6.7.21
- ~~Prepackaging of raw agricultural produce such as fruits, potatoes, peppers, etc., to the extent possible.~~ - Rev_6.7.21
- Prepared foods must be packaged to take home. **see sampling above** - Rev_6.7.21
- Prepared foods may ~~only~~ **be eaten off market grounds, or in designated food areas where individuals are seated.** - Rev_6.7.21
- ~~Suspension of on-site eating.~~ - Rev_6.7.21
- Entertainment allowed as long as groups do not gather in & around entertainers.
- Customers who are fully vaccinated do not need to wear masks but are encouraged to do so.
- Children allowed. Children 2+, masks required **unless vaccinated.** - Rev_6.7.21
